Senate Bill 257 - Technology

Authored by the late Senator David Ford (R- Hartford City), this measure requires the legislative council to assign to an interim or a statutory committee the topic of modernizing the system for filing mechanic's liens through incorporation of a statewide online registry. The bill, which passed the General Assembly, requires the state budget agency in conjunction with the office of technology to review and make recommendations to the legislative council concerning state agency use of legacy high-volume, transaction processing systems. The bill is now awaiting action by Governor Daniels and is expected to be signed into law.
